RE: Notice of Construction – 15th Avenue East (22 – 28 Street)

The City of Prince Albert Public Works Department would like to advise residents of upcoming roadway rehabilitation work on **15th Avenue East between 22nd and 28th Street**. The project includes asphalt milling, paving, and select concrete repairs. Please refer to the attached map for project limits.

Project Schedule: July 25 to July 31, 2026 (*weather permitting*)

Impacted Area: Construction activities will occur within the area outlined in **orange** on the attached map.

Phase 1 – Site Preparation (Completed)

Earlier this week, the City's Water and Sewer Division completed sewer main repairs beneath 15th Avenue East in preparation for roadway rehabilitation.

Phase 2 – Asphalt Milling & Concrete Work (Beginning, Saturday, July 25)

During this phase, local access to **15th Avenue East** and **Helme Crescent** will remain available from the north; however, residents are asked to limit vehicle movements where possible

- Select concrete repairs will be completed where required. Repair locations will be identified with pink spray paint.
- "No Parking" signs will be installed one day before milling operations begin.

Phase 3 – Asphalt Paving

Paving will occur in two stages:

- **Bottom Lift:** There will be approximately two days of bottom lift paving. Local access to **15th Avenue East** and **Helme Crescent** will remain available from the north; however, residents are asked to limit vehicle movements where possible. Short delays may occur while the contractor facilitates access.
- **Top Lift:** The final asphalt lift will be completed over two days in two sections (shown in **red** and **blue** on the attached map). Each section is expected to be fully closed for approximately **24 hours**. During this time, **no vehicle access will be permitted**. Residents must not drive on the newly placed asphalt until it has cured and all road closures have been removed.

Parking, Access and Traffic

- No on-street parking will be permitted on 15th Avenue East for the duration of the project.
- The intersection of 15th Avenue East and 28th Street is expected to remain closed throughout construction.
- Primary access to Crescent Acres will be maintained via Muzzy Drive, with Barton Drive available as a secondary detour for local traffic.
- Driveway access will be temporarily restricted while work is taking place directly in front of your property. Due to the nature of construction, exact closure times cannot be provided in advance.

Fresh Asphalt

Residents are asked **not to drive on freshly paved asphalt or tack oil**. Fresh asphalt and tack oil can adhere to vehicle tires and damage the new roadway surface. Please wait until road closures have been removed before accessing the roadway.

Waste Collection: Waste Collection will continue as normal for Helme Crescent. Residents on 15th Avenue East within the Construction area are asked to place their waste receptacles in the back alley for pickup. If you are unable to place your bin in this location pickup will resume as normal on Wednesday, August 5.

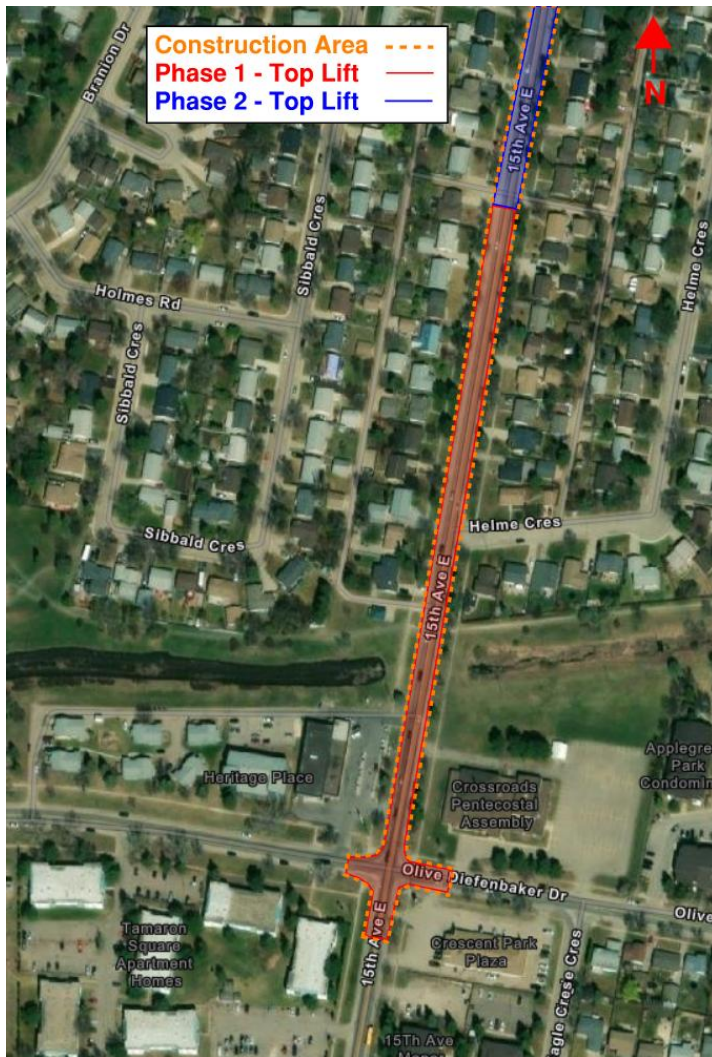


Figure 1: South Extents of Project
