BYLAW NO. 38 OF 2010

A Bylaw of The City of Prince Albert to Authorize the Sale and Consumption of Alcohol at the Art Hauser Centre

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN
OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Statutory Authority

1. The authority to regulate the consumption of liquor at City of Prince Albert facilities under this Bylaw is section 8 of *The Cities Act* and section 16 of *The Alcohol Control Regulations, 2002*.

Definitions

2. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) **"Beverage Alcohol"** has the same meaning as is in *The Alcohol and Gaming Regulations Act, 1997*;
 - (b) **"Home Game"** means all sanctioned regular season and playoff games of the Prince Albert Raider Hockey Club Inc.;
 - (c) **"Special Events"** means all exhibitions, promotions, entertainment, performances, or athletic competitions (excluding Home Games) at which the sale and consumption of beverage alcohol is proposed, conducted with the prior approval of the City Manager or his designate;

Sale of Beverage Alcohol

3. Beverage Alcohol may be sold and consumed at the Art Hauser Centre:
 - (a) at any Special Event, provided that there shall be no more than 6 Special Events during any calendar year;

- (b) by or on behalf of the Prince Albert Raider Hockey Club Inc. at any Home Game; and

upon those terms and conditions set by the Liquor and Gaming Authority for the Province of Saskatchewan.

Authorization

4. The Director of Community Services or his or her designate is authorized to consider and in his or her judgement approve or deny applications for Special Events.

Coming into Force

5. This Bylaw comes into force upon its passage.
