The purpose of this letter is to formally request for in-kind, sponsorships, and collaboration for our Ceremonial & Culture grounds at Little Red River Park in the City limits of Prince Albert. Our goal is to provide both Indigenous and Non-Indigenous Peoples with an opportunity to engage in cultural traditions and to strengthen the connection to our culture among our families, youth and communities.

We are currently working collaboratively with multiple stakeholders and partners on creating continuity for our community for Urban Indigenous Families. As Prince Albert is a known for its high Indigenous population with the census from 2023 being 46%, and that an urban Ceremonial & Cultural Grounds is much needed in our community.

Objectives:

- Strengthen connections for Indigenous youth and families with tradition, language, culture, and land-based healing.
- Foster a greater sense of belonging for Indigenous youth and families in the community.
- Ceremonial & Cultural Infrastructure & Spaces in an Urban setting.
- Promote education and awareness to help reduce risk-taking behaviors, including gang involvement, intergenerational trauma, mental health struggles, addictions, homelessness and unhealthy living.
- Addressing the 94 Calls to Action with Reconciliation with Indigenous and non-Indigenous persons.

To ensure the success of the Ceremonial & Cultural Grounds we are seeking financial support in offsetting the cost from your organization or business. These funds will contribute to Phase 1 of the project in which will help with the Traditional sweat house, Road Improvements & Infrastructure, and Traditional Pow-Wow Arbor Structures. The funds will also go towards Land-based equipment, and other supplies needed, ultimately allowing us to provide a meaningful experience for the youth and families who come to celebrate/practice our rich cultural heritage.
