

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT

BY-LAW NO ~~24~~ ²⁴ OF 1908

A By-Law to increase the number of Alderman of the City of Prince Albert.

WHEREAS it has been deemed expedient to increase the number of Alderman of the City of Prince Albert from six to ~~8~~ ⁸ in accordance with the powers conferred upon the City by the Council by the City Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Mayor and Council of the City of Prince Albert in Council assembled enact as follows;

1. The number of Alderman composing the Council of the City of Prince Albert, shall on and after the 1st day of January 1909 be ~~8~~ ⁸
2. ~~8~~ The first election of the said Alderman necessary to complete the required number shall take place in accordance with the provisions of the City Act on the 1st day in December A.D. 1908.
3. At the said election the first ~~4~~ ⁴ candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall be respectively elected for the term of two years, and the ~~1st~~ ^{2nd} candidate receiving the next highest number of votes shall respectively be elected for the space of one year.
4. At every subsequent election held in accordance with the terms of the City Act, the Alderman elected at such election shall hold office for the term of two years.

Read a third time and passed this ~~16~~ ¹⁶th day of November A.D. 1908.
