BYLAW NO. 5 OF 1970.

A Bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to recognize persons who make an outstanding contribution to the City of Prince Albert, the Province of Saskatchewan or the Dominion of Canada.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince Albert deems it desirable to provide that persons who make an outstanding contribution of great significance to the City of Prince Albert, the Province of Saskatchewan or the Dominion of Canada, may be honoured by the City Council by being named an honorary citizen of this City.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Council of the City of Prince Albert hereby provides that, by a unanimous vote of the City Council, a person who has made a personal contribution of great significance to the City, the Province of Saskatchewan, or the Dominion of Canada may be named an Honorary Citizen.
2. The names of persons so named shall be inscribed on the permanent list of Honorary Citizens, which list shall be displayed prominently in the City's Council Chamber.
3. The names of honorary citizens shall also be listed on a separate page as a frontispiece to the Annual Voters' List.
4. In addition, a suitably inscribed scroll, carrying a brief citation of the achievements of the Honorary Citizen shall be presented to the person honoured, at a suitable ceremony.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the passing thereof.
